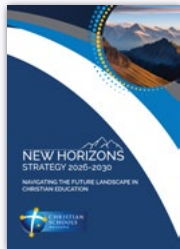

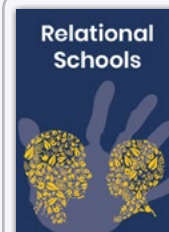

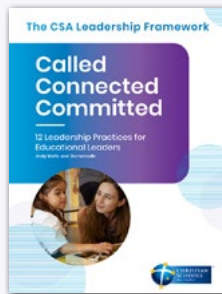
Leadership

The **CSA Formation Framework** has been developed to help schools thoughtfully consider their approach to student formation. 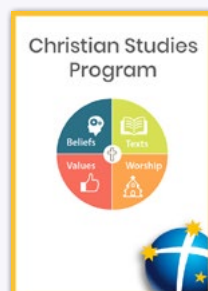

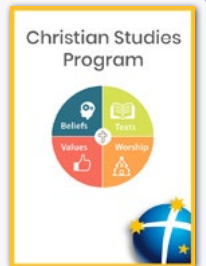
