## ABOUT THE PROGRAM:

Are you an Early Childhood Educator, Preschool or Prep Teacher, Teacher Aide, or OSHC Coordinator? Do you hold a qualification (Certificate III or higher) and have experience working with young children?

In July 2026, we're assembling a small team of 12–15 qualified adults to travel to Cambodia to support **Glow Early Learning** — a purpose-built Early Learning Centre in Phnom Penh dedicated to nurturing each child's growth, imagination, and sense of belonging through play, discovery, and love of learning.

Glow's permanent educators will be on a scheduled professional break, and this volunteer team will help ensure the centre continues to provide high-quality, safe, and engaging care during this time.

This program offers a rare opportunity to combine **professional development** and **cross-cultural experience**, while contributing your expertise in a meaningful and lasting way.

## WHAT YOU'LL DO

You'll design and deliver a one-week holiday program for children aged 12 weeks to 6 years old, guided by Glow Early Learning's philosophy of nurturing curiosity and care. Working alongside local staff, you'll help create a joyful environment where children can continue to learn, play, and thrive.

Team members will collaborate to plan and implement daily activities including storytime, craft, music, sensory play, and movement experiences.

## CULTURAL & IMMERSION EXPERIENCE

Before beginning the volunteer program, you'll spend several days exploring Cambodia's incredible history and culture. You'll visit the World Heritage-listed **Angkor Wat** in Siem Reap, travel through the scenic countryside to Phnom Penh, and learn about Cambodia's resilience and hope through visits to local historical sites and community organisations. This immersive experience will deepen your understanding of education, family life, and early learning in a global context.
